According to the legend, King Vakhtang Gorgasali founded Tbilisi after a hunting trip near the former capital city of Mtskheta. While in pursuit of a pheasant, his falcon led him to a hot spring where both birds accidentally boiled. Recognizing the potential benefits of such natural springs, the king decided to establish a new capital on the site, which he aptly named Tbilisi ('tbili' in Georgian means 'warm'). Today, the city boasts numerous hot sulphur springs, most notably in the Abanotubani district, where the famous sulphur baths can be found.

Tbilisi's strategic location on the southeastern edge of Europe, along lucrative east-west trade routes, has contributed to its vibrant cultural diversity and cosmopolitan atmosphere. As you wander through the city, you'll encounter a fascinating mix of cultures and traditions. In addition, the Georgian Government approved the list of 50 countries whose visa and/or residence permit holders may enter Georgia without a visa for an appropriate period and under appropriate conditions. 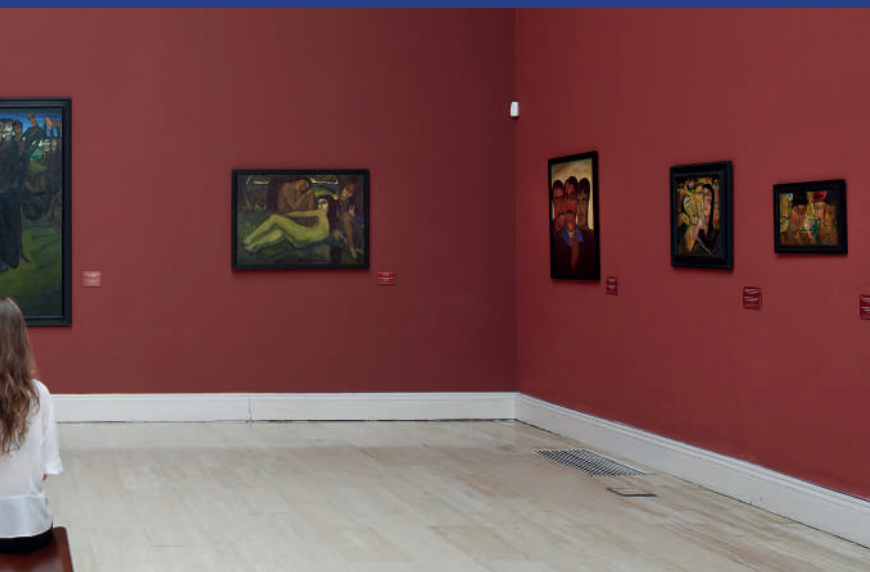


MUSEUMS

You are about to discover a country rich in history, traditions, hospitality and friendship. A fertile land that became home to the earliest remains of modern man found outside of Africa, dating back nearly 1.7 – 1.8 million years. Many countries have ancient roots, but unlike Georgia, only few can provide the missing link in human expansion between Africa and Asia. From the oldest residents of the Eurasia continent named -Zezva and Mzia, to the Ancient Greek myth of Jason and the Argonauts and their search for the golden fleece, and the King



who converted Georgian to Christianity in 4th century A.D. Tbilisi has an amazing story to tell; a “Treasury” of the pre-Christian era archaeological materials, gold and silver jewelry (VII-XIX cc.), fascinating paintings by famous Georgian painters, Pirosmiani, Gudiashvili and Kakabadze. Whichever place you visit the city’s eclectic culture and heritage will captivate your heart.




OPEN AIR MUSEUM OF ETHNOGRAPHY

Founded in 1966, the Open Air Museum of Ethnography contains 70 different buildings on its premises. They represent the life of the Georgian people in different regions of the country. Altogether there are 8000 artifacts exhibited in the Museum. Georgian traditions and culture are brought

to life in the artifacts that are presented to the guests of the museum. Several staff members wearing traditional clothes from different regions of the country are ready to assist the guests and tell them about the Georgian way of life. Every weekend visiting guests can participate in various activities, such as baking Georgian bread or cooking the Georgian dishes.

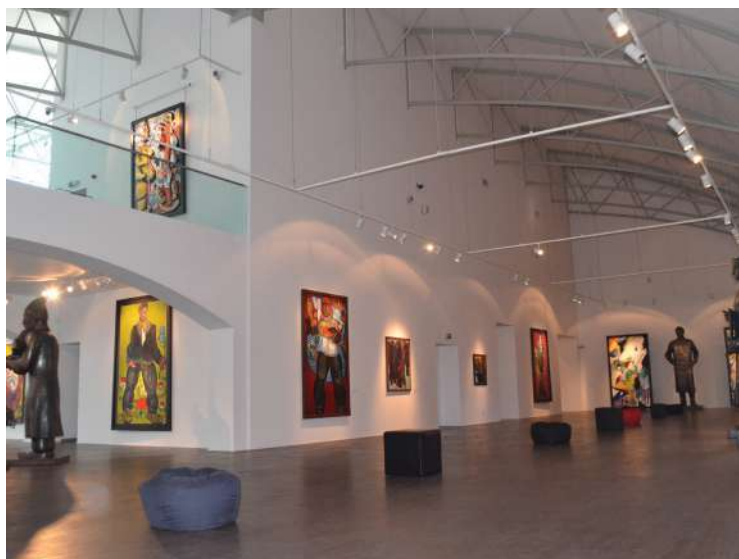
MOMA TBILISI

The Museum represents a 3-story exhibition space, which is located in the heart of Tbilisi's center – Rustaveli avenue. The building where the Museum of Modern Art of Zurab Tsereteli is situated was rehabilitated during 2007-2012. Zurab Tsereteli began the reconstruction and restoration of the former Tbilisi Cadet Corps to locate a museum in it. Following the rehabilitation, the building retained the external style and the historic details, while the internal space was changed completely, which resulted in the establishment of a modern gallery, including new exhibition halls.

Monthly exhibitions of Georgian as well as foreign artists are held in the exhibition space of the museum located on the first floor. Second and third floors host permanent personal exhibition of Zurab Tsereteli.

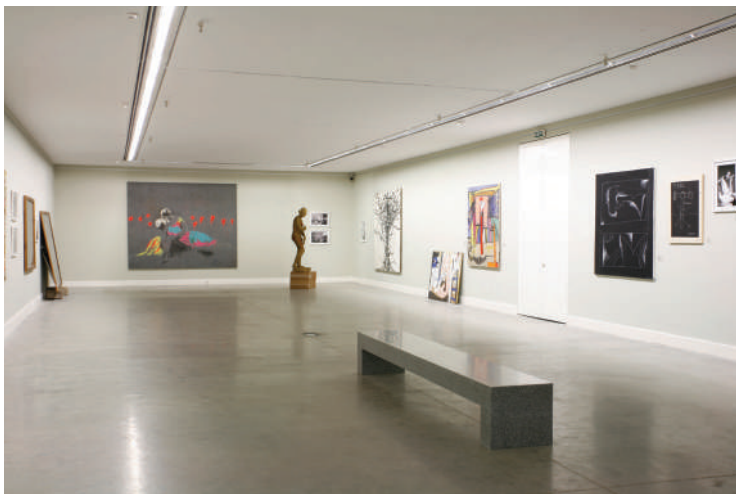

DIMITRY SHEVARDNADZE GEORGIAN NATIONAL GALLERY

Through the initiative of Georgian artists Dimitri Shevardnadze in 1920 the former building of “Fame” was transformed into the National Gallery, the building played a dominant role in the cultural life of the XX century Georgia. In accordance with international exhibition standards the second floor of the National Gallery holds works of Niko Pirosmiani, Lado Gudiashvili, Davit Kakabadze, Iakob Nikoladze and other artifacts. The first floor of the gallery encompasses the works of the modern art, illustrating the current processes of international and educational projects of cultural life.

THE GEORGIAN MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS

In 2018, Tbilisi was enriched with a new cultural hub, the Georgian Museum of Fine Arts found on the main avenue in the heart of the city. Although the exposition space here is private, it is certainly of national importance, given its considerable scope.

The Georgian Museum of Fine Arts displays the private family collection of Gia Jokhtaberidze and Manana Sehvardnadze, one bringing together 3,500 works by almost 80 artists.

The museum's collection is unique in that it makes the first time when examples of Georgian Fine Arts from the past 70 years are brought together in a single exhibition space for wider audiences to view.

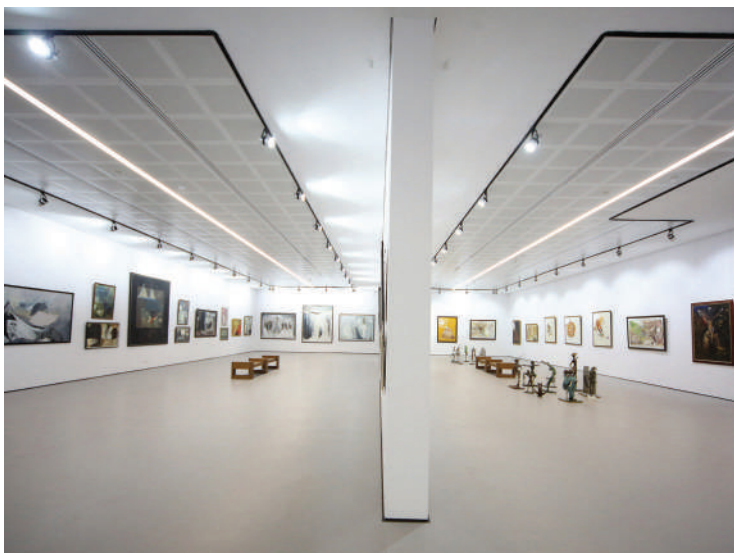
The museum occupies a place of historical significance, with the first architectural structure built here in 1868.

IOSEB GRISHASHVILI TBILISI HISTORY MUSEUM (KARVASLA)

Karvasla – Ioseb Grishashvili Tbilisi History Museum was founded in 1910. In 1943, as the Tbilisi State Historical and Ethnographic museum, it was placed in a historic building – a former caravan-sarai Mantashev building. At the exhibition “XIX century multi-Tbilisi”, visitors can explore the artifacts from Georgian, Armenian, Azerbaijani, Kurdish, Jewish, Eastern and European cultures. Besides, there is an exhibition of the photographs of the XIX century Tbilisi, depicting the transport and the interiors of the city, as well as Asian and European monuments, handmade works, clothes and more.

SIMON JANASHIA MUSEUM OF GEORGIA

Considered to be founded on May the 10th 1852 at the Simon Janashia Museum of Georgia you can visit a permanent exhibition, “archaeological treasures“, which encompasses 600 artifacts of goldsmithing discovered as a result of the archaeological exploration on the territory of Georgia. The exhibition represents the development of the Georgian culture between III millennium BC and IV century AD. The exhibition called “Archaeology of the IV century BC VIII millennium” reflects the general development of the Georgian culture and an unbroken line from the epoch of the Neolithic era until the late antique era. S. Janashia Museum also holds a permanent exhibition dedicated to the Soviet period, displaying the 70- year rule of the Soviet occupation regime in Georgia. The exhibition is rich with photos, videos and documents. Besides, you can also visit café and shops inside the museum.

THE STATE SILK MUSEUM

The State Silk Museum was founded in 1887. The museum building was built as a station for Caucasian silkworm breeders and constitutes a Cultural Heritage Monument. When you visit the museum, you'll learn about the people in Georgia who knew the secret of making silk fibres before the common era, as well as about the special properties for which Georgian silk is famous, and the prizes won by Georgian silk at the international exhibitions of Tunisia in 1850 and London in 1862. More recently, in 1998, Georgian silk was awarded a platinum star from the European Quality Committee at the Spanish exhibition. The museum houses a diverse collection of items related to silkworm breeding, from both Georgia and sixty-one other countries around the world. Here you will see the oldest collection of silkworm cocoons from the world's silkworm breeding countries, with 5,000 species and varieties; a collection of 19th-century handmade fabrics from the Caucasus; a collection of French silk Jacquard fabrics from the 1860s; a collection of more than 400 pieces of German lace and more.



SHALVA AMIRANASHVILI MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS

Since 1950 the Museum of Fine Arts is located in the building, which was designed in the late 1830s by G. Bernardatsi. The treasury of the Museum displays archaeological materials of the pre-Christian era, golden and silver jewelry. Georgian goldsmith masterpieces of the Christian era

(VII-XIX cc.), Engraved and painted icons, crosses, enamel collection, jewelry, and Georgian embroidery of the XII-XIX centuries. Collection of works by Niko Pirosmani, Lado Gudiashvili, David Kakabadze, Elene Akhvlediani, Gigo Gabashvili, and other famous painters.

TBILISI DIGITAL SPACE

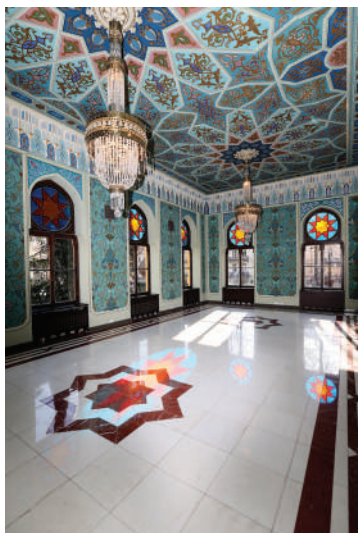
TBILISI Z. PALIASHVILI OPERA AND BALLET STATE THEATER

“This is the only theatre in the city, the interior of which is totally Moorish in style, and it is undoubtedly one of the most elegant, beautiful and fascinating theatre buildings that mankind has seen.” (L’Illustration, October 25, 1851).

The history of the Tbilisi Opera House began more than 165 years ago. On April 12, 1851, the first opera house in Transcaucasia was inaugurated with a Grand Masked Ball, attended by the high society of Tbilisi. But on October 11, 1874, this opera house was destroyed by a fire. In 1896, the present building, designed by the architect Victor Schröter, was completed.

This building, too, suffered damages in the course of time, but was restored to its original form in 1978 preserving the oriental, neo-Moorish style of the building.

On January 30, 2016, the Tbilisi Opera House was reopened to the public after comprehensive six-year renovation.

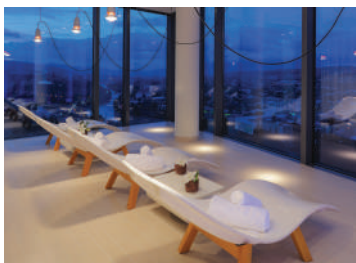

Fed by naturally hot mineral waters (47°C) the sulphur baths have been an essential part of life in Tbilisi for centuries. The brick-domed under-ground bath were built in the 17th century and produce 3 million liters of water every day. To make your visit complete, make sure to have the invigorating message. High in sulphurs and other minerals, with a constant temperature of 38°C to 40°C, the waters have long been used as a therapeutic aid for a range of illnesses including skin conditions and arthritis.







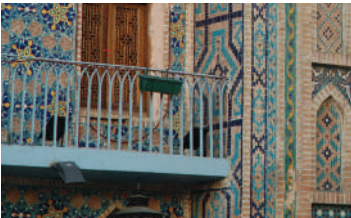

GEORGIA CRADLE OF WINE

Georgia embodies the future of wine with its unique varieties and mysterious ancient methods, dating back to the depths of centuries, may even become a discovery for the whole world. One can say for sure that the ancient traces of vine culture are all preserved in Georgia. Grape stones dating back to the 6th millennium BC were found by archeologists several decades ago in Kvemo Kartli (south of Tbilisi), at Marneuli Valley, the prehistoric settlement of Dangreuli Gora. Georgian wine has an 8,000 - year history. That is why Georgia is known as the cradle of wine.



The barrique method of barrel fermentation and storage is now virtually standard practice. However, the old Caucasian method of wine making is still widely practiced in Georgia, mostly in the eastern part of the country, particularly in Kakheti, where grapes are placed in large, earthenware vessels called Qvevri, buried in the ground, sealed and left for several months to reach a natural and delicious maturity. An early type of Qvevri was found on Mount Khrami and is believed to date back to the 6th millennium BC and many Qvevris from this and later periods have been found in both Eastern and Western Georgia.

GEORGIAN DISHES

Authentic and very specific to the country, Georgian cuisine is the natural extension of a rich landscape - fed by the pure waters of the Caucasus Mountains. The cuisine offers a variety of dishes, high in herbs and spices, and mix of vegetarian and meat dishes: organic fresh meat like pork and lamb, chicken and fish, hazelnuts and walnuts, various sorts of cheese, and pungent seasonings.

STARTERS

Georgian Cheese – Georgian Cheese assortment is full of various cheese platters from all regions of Georgia.

Nadughi – Georgia Cheese with mint.

Khachapuri – Georgian cheese bread, also known as Georgian pizza, cooked to a number of regional styles.

Lobiani – “Bean khachapuri”, bread baked with a seasoned bean stuffing and aromatic spices. Traditionally served on the Georgian holiday of Barbaroba (St. Barbara’s Day) celebrated on December 17.

Pkhali – Vegetarian dishes from a variety of spiced plants usually with a walnut paste base, similar to spinach, but each having a unique taste and seasoning. Among these are: Jijilaka, Moloqa and Ekala.

Spinach with walnut – Spinach with ground walnut seasoning, spices and herbs.

Eggplants with walnuts – Eggplants seasoned with ground walnuts, vinegar (or pomegranate juice), garlic, pomegranate seeds and spices.

Mchadi – Cornbread. Can be small and thick fried in oil, or thin and wide with a crunchy texture. Either way, it goes very well with cheese.

SOUPS

Kharcho – Tender chicken soup Chikhirtma with eggs whipped in vinegar and a transparent light meat broth flavoured with garlic, parsley and fennel.

Khashi – A broth cooked from beef entrails and lavishly seasoned with garlic.

MAIN DISHES

Khinkali – The Georgian National dish: juicy meat dumplings made to be eaten by hand, using a special technique that can be learned only here. Visitors end up craving this dish so much they make special trips back just to taste it again.

Satsivi – Chicken or Turkey in walnut sauce with garlic and spices.

Mtsvadi – Georgian barbeque, meat grilled to perfection over a grape vine-wood fire, with fresh pomegranate juice squeezed over it.

SAUCES

Baje – Ground walnut sauce with garlic and spices. Great with everything.

Ajika – Georgia's own spicy hot sauce filled with herbs and spices.

Tkemali – Georgian ketchup, but so much more... A red or green sour plumb sauce made from the fruit of the tkemali tree. No one leaves the country without a bottle.

DESSERTS

Churchkhela – Walnuts on a thread repeatedly dipped into a hot grape mixture, then hung to dry.

Gozinaki – Is a traditional Georgian confection made of caramelized nuts, usually walnuts, fried in honey, and served mainly on New Year's Eve and Christmas.

Pelamushi – Georgian desserts traditionally take their flavor from fruit and nuts rather than butter and eggs. Pelamushi is a Georgian delicacy made from grape juice extract, combined with a mixture of sugar and flour.

Currency

The official currency is GEL. There are many ATMs throughout the city and almost all shops accept different types of credit cards, though we recommend having cash with you for souvenirs.

Pharmacy/Supermarkets

You'll find 24-hour supermarkets and pharmacies in each district of the city, selling daily needs and more.

Delivery companies such as Wolt, Glovo, Bolt, and Elvis are also operating 24/7 hours, having a wide assortment of food, products, household items, and more.

Most of the food spots work from 11:00 till 22:00; you'll find early birds and night restaurants as well.

Connection

You'll find internet in almost every cafe, bar, and restaurant and free wifi in the streets of Tbilisi, called "Tbilisi Loves You."

If you want to have your own 5G data, you can buy a tourist sim card at International airports or Mobile operator offices. (Mobile operator companies: Geocell/Silknet, Magti and Cellfie).

You can buy a sim card with 7 days of unlimited internet for 20 gel.
